

## Parish Subsidy Grant

Pastors have agreed to participate for the coming school year the amount of \$800.00 per student, provided you are following the guidelines established by the parish where you are registered. You must be participating by sharing your time, talents, and treasures. Application forms available at your parish office after February 1.

Saint Mary Catholic Church is committed to an additional subsidized amount. This amount is in addition to the parish subsidy from your parish. Pastors will review their commitment twice a year and can invoke the non-participating status to the family if they are not meeting the requirements for the subsidy.

## Grant Information

Saint Mary Catholic School has the following grant information available to assist families who need financial assistance. It is our hope that these grants will enable any parent to choose a Catholic education for their child(ren).

### Important information and steps to take when applying:

**\*Read all requirements for eligibility before applying.**

**\* Include the required documents.**

**\* Be aware of deadlines.**

**\* Apply first to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment Online when applicable.**

**\* Apply for all grants that you are eligible to receive.**

### FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment

In order to receive financial assistance, you must submit your financial information to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment which will determine if there is a need based on the information you provide (not necessary for the Step Up For Students.) Applications must be submitted online at: [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com)

Current tax information is required to apply for financial assistance. After completing the online application, you will need to mail or fax the supporting documentation.
