

Probation Period Policy

All students entering Saint Mary Catholic School for the first time and new to our diocesan school system are accepted on a probationary semester basis. This probationary status may be extended based on the Principal's discretion for another semester. The probationary period is intended to benefit both the student and the school. During the probationary period, if necessary, parents may be asked to attend a parent conference to discuss their student's progress. Saint Mary Catholic School strives to provide a Christ-centered learning environment that promotes academic success and personal responsibility.

During the probationary semester period, if the school determines the student is unable to perform adequately in this environment, the student will be asked to find another educational setting. Any prepaid tuition will be prorated and refunded. Grades will not be released until all accounts are current. Fees are non-refundable. The probationary period may be extended at the discretion of the Principal.
